The Polish American Congress Michigan Division organized the Mass or Remembrance on Sunday, April 9, at St. Faustina Church in Warren.

The Mass was celebrated to remember and honor the victims of the Katyn Forest Massacre of April 1940, commemorating the 77th anniversary of this brutal execution of more than 20,000 Polish officers, intellectuals, and clergy by the

Soviets, as well as to remember the victims of the airplane crash near Smolensk on April 10, 2010, on the 7th anniversary of this tragedy, in which 96 members of Poland's elite died along with the late President, Lech Kaczynski.

The PAC-MI would like to express a sincere "thank-you" to everyone involved in organizing the Mass and all who participated.
