#### PAC-MI celebrates 2017 Kościuszko Year

#### UNESCO patrons Kościuszko's death bicentenary

UNESCO (The United Nations Educational. Scientific and Cultural Organization) has taken over patronage of observances marking Tadeusz Kosciuszko's death bicentenary, planned for this year. A motion for UNESCO patronage over the bicentenary was submitted jointly by the Kosciuszko Mound Committee in Krakow (south Poland), the Kosciuszko Foundation in New York and Kosciuszko Heritage Inc. in Sydney.

Tadeusz Kościuszko (1746-1817) was a Polish military engineer and a military leader who became a national hero in Poland, Lithuania, Belarus, and the United States. He fought in the Polish-Lithuanian

Commonwealth's struggles against Russia and Prussia, and on the American side in the American Revolutionary War. As Supreme Commander of the Polish National Armed Forces, he led the 1794 Kościuszko Uprising.

One of Kościuszko's most significant and poignant achievements was his pursuit into freeing African-American slaves. He made several wills, notably one in 1798 stipulating that the proceeds of his American estate be spent on freeing and educating African-American slaves, including those of his friend Thomas Jefferson, whom he named as the will's executor.

The City of Detrot is graced with a marvelous monument of Tadeusz Kościuszko. It is located on the corner of Third Street and Michigan Avenue in downtown Detroit. This cast statue is the work of the Warsaw-born Italian-Polish sculptor, Leonard Marconi. It was cast in 1889 for the grounds of the Wawel Castle in Kraków. To honor Detroit on the bicentennial of the United States, the city of Kraków had the statue donated to the city.

The Polish American Congress Michigan Division is joining in celebration marking Tadeusz Kościuszko's death bicentenary. We have produced a special pamphlet (pictured) about the life and accomplishments of Kościuszko. The pamphlet will

be available for anyone interested to find out about this great Polish man at the Polish Folk Dance Festival at the American Polish Cultural Center in Troy on Saturday, February 11, where we will have our booth with promotional materials including the Kościuszko pamphlet and his statue for viewing. ## PAC-MI TO HOLD ELECTION MEETING

On Saturday, March 18, 2017, the Polish American Congress-Michigan Division will hold its Annual General Membership Meeting. The officers and chairmen of all committees will present their annual reports.

During the meeting, an election of officers and members of the board will take place.

Until February 16 the Nominating Committee is accepting nominations for all the elected positions in the governing body of the PAC-MI.

The Nominating Committee accepts only written nominations, and only of those candidates that are eligible, according to the PAC-MI By-Laws (candidate must be a member of the PAC Michigan Division for at least one year prior to the date of the election; i.e., prior to March 18, 2017 and, in case of Executive Offices must have attended at least one quarterly membership meeting during the 12 months preceding the date of the election meeting). The Nominating Committee shall verify the willingness of each candidate nominated and at the Election Meeting will present the list of nominations.

If the election meeting requires voting, only PAC-MI members in good standings (with paid dues for 2016) and delegates of the organizations in good standings (with paid dues for 2016) will be eligible to participate in the voting process (the eligibility will be checked at the door).

On Saturday, April 8, all the newly elected officers and members of the board, will give the oath of office, during an Installation Ceremony, at the Polish National Alliance Council 122 Banquet Hall in Hamtramck.


